Career Fair Contest (the "Contest")

OFFICIAL RULES AND REGULATIONS

- 1. **ELIGIBILITY** - The Contest is open to legal residents of Canada, (excluding residents of the Province of Quebec), who are enrolled as a full-time or part-time student in an Engineering department at a post-secondary educational institution in Canada. The Contest is not open to employees (and persons with whom they are domiciled) of Stuart Olson Dominion Construction Ltd. ("**SODCL**"), their affiliated companies and advertising and promotions agencies. For the purposes of this Contest, a "**post-secondary educational institution**" means (a) a university, college or other educational institution providing courses at a post-secondary school level, or (b) certified by the Minister of Human Resources Development to be an educational institution providing courses (other than courses designed for university credit) that furnish a student with skills for, or improve a student's skills in, an occupation.
- 2. **HOW TO ENTER** - The Contest will commence on January 18, 2012 at 8:00 a.m. (MST) and end on March 30, 2012 at 11:59 p.m. (MST) (the "**Contest Period**"). To enter, eligible participants must have Internet access and a valid email address. To enter, register and complete all required details and follow the Contest entry instructions provided below:
 - Visit the Stuart Olson Dominion Construction booth at your respective post-secondary institution Engineering Career Fair during the Contest Period.
 - Visit the SODCL website www.sodcl.com
 - Follow the instructions found under the **Career Fair Contest** tab and fill out the entry form with all required information which will include your full name, telephone number and email address and complete the skill testing question.
 - Once you submit the form, you will automatically receive one (1) Contest entry.

A person can use only one (1) email address to register. Any attempt by any entrant to obtain more than one (1) entry by using multiple/different email addresses, identities, registrations and logins, or any other methods will void that entrant's entries and that entrant may be disqualified. Use of any automated system to participate is prohibited and will result in disqualification.

- 3. **NO PURCHASE NECESSARY** - Internet access required. Online entry through the SODCL website only; no other means of submission will be accepted. Although online access and an email account are required in order to participate, no purchase is required in order to enter the Contest. Many public libraries, retail businesses and others offer free access to computers and a number of Internet service providers and other companies offer free email accounts. Any attempts to exceed the maximum number of entries allowed is a violation of these Official Rules and may result in disqualification of the entry and/or entrant, and the forfeit of any prize. All entries must be received by the end of the Contest Period. Proof of submission of an entry does not constitute proof of receipt by SODCL. The Contest is in no way sponsored, endorsed or administered by, or associated with Facebook.
- 4. **PRIZE** - There is one (1) prize to be won (the "**Prize**"). The odds of winning the Prize in the Contest depend upon the number of eligible entries received. The Prize consists of:
 - One (1) iPad 2 valued at approximately \$720 dollars (\$720 USD).

On or about April 2, 2012, a random draw will be conducted by a representative of SODCL for the Prize. In order to win, the selected entrant must have correctly answered the skill-testing question. The winner will be notified by email or telephone within five (5) days of the draw and will be required to sign (or their parent/legal guardian for a winner who is under the age of majority) a standard liability/publicity release within ten (10) business days of notification. If a selected entrant cannot be contacted by email or telephone or fails to return the contest documents within the specified time, he/she will forfeit the Prize and an alternate winner will be randomly selected. SODCL is not responsible for any change in contact information of entrants.

By entering the Contest, participants agree to be bound by these Official Rules and by the decisions of the Contest judges, which shall be final on all matters relating to the Contest. All entries become the property of SODCL and none will be returned. The personal information provided by entrants will only be used for the purpose of administration of the Contest. By entering, participants understand that they are providing the personal information to SODCL and not to Facebook.
- SODCL is not responsible for incomplete, lost, late, damaged, illegible or misdirected emails or for any technical problems, malfunctions of any telephone lines, computer systems, servers, providers, hardware/software, lost or unavailable network connections or failed, incomplete, garbled or delayed computer transmission or any combination thereof.
- By participating in this Contest, all participants release SODCL, its affiliates, and their employees, directors, officers, representatives and agents and Facebook from all liability for any damage that may result from entering or attempting to enter the contest.
